*Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*

Nominations are called for:

**FEDERAL CONFERENCE DELEGATES REPRESENTING THE GENERAL DIVISION – Six (6) – Three (3) OF WHOM SHALL BE FEMALE** (elected by and from the financial members assigned to the General Division) *(If the number of female candidates is less than the number of female delegates to be elected the remaining office/s in question will be filled by male candidate/s)*

**FEDERAL CONFERENCE DELEGATE REPRESENTING THE TAFE DIVISION – One (1)** (elected by and from the financial members assigned to the TAFE Division)

**ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER FEDERAL CONFERENCE DELEGATE – One (1)** (the member being nominated and the nominators must be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander members)

**\*NATIONAL TAFE COUNCIL DELEGATES – Two (2)**

**NATIONAL TAFE COUNCIL EXECUTIVE MEMBER – One (1)**

**(all elected by and from the financial members assigned to the TAFE Division)**

*\*Of the above three (3) TAFE delegates, two (2) shall be female (If the number of female candidates is less than the number of female delegates to be elected the remaining office/s in question will be filled by male candidate/s)*

**YALUKIT YULENDJ (NATIONAL ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER COMMITTEE) (GENERAL DIVISION) MEMBER – One (1)** (the member being nominated and the nominators must be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander members)

**YALUKIT YULENDJ (NATIONAL ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER COMMITTEE) (TAFE DIVISION) MEMBER – One (1)** (the member being nominated and the nominators must be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander members)

**NATIONAL PRINCIPALS' COMMITTEE (GENERAL DIVISION) MEMBER – One (1)** (the member being nominated and the nominators must be current Principals)

**NATIONAL EARLY CHILDHOOD COMMITTEE (GENERAL DIVISION) MEMBER – One (1)** (the member being nominated and the nominators must be current early childhood practitioners)

**Nominations**, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the organisation, may be made at any time from **Thursday, 10 August 2017**. They must reach my office or postal address or AEC email inbox **not later than 12noon (AWST) Thursday, 31 August 2017**.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after **12noon (AWST) Thursday, 31 August 2017**. Withdrawal of nominations must be in writing and addressed to Simon Bulloch, Returning Officer at one of the addresses listed below.

Members' attention is drawn to the appropriate Federal and Branch rules of the Union regarding the eligibility to be a candidate, a nominator and to vote.

The ballot, if required, will open on Friday, 22 September 2017 and close at 10:00 am (AWST) on Thursday, 19 October 2017.
