Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit only one statement regardless of the number of positions they are contesting in support of their candidature in accordance with Rule 28 of CPSU Chapter C - SPSF Group rules of the organisation. A statement must be no longer than 200 words in length and should be submitted to the Returning Officer as a word document, either by email to waelections@aec.gov.au or on a CD, **by 12noon (AWST) on Tuesday, 18 April 2017**. Only

statements which comply with the Organisation's rules will be published. To assist candidates, a standard "Candidate Statement Form" is available for use at www.aec.gov.au

You may call the contact number provide to check.

The ballot, if required, will open on Wednesday, 17 May 2017 and close at 10:00am (AWST) on Tuesday, 6 June 2017.
