The rules of the Organisation provide that where the number of female candidates for positions is less than the number of female delegates to be elected, remaining positions will be filled by a male candidate or candidates.

NOMINATIONS: Written nominations which comply with the registered rules of the organisation, may be made at any time from Monday 24 July 2017. They must reach my office or postal address or AEC email inbox **not later than 5pm (AEST) on Tuesday 8 August 2017**. Nominations cannot be withdrawn after this time. A Nomination Form is enclosed with this notice. Additional forms are available from me or the branch office of the organisation.

STATEMENTS: In accordance with the Tasmanian Federal Branch Rule 32(7), a candidate may, **not later than 5pm (AEST) Tuesday 15 August 2017**, submit to the AEC Returning Officer a statement (together with a passport-size photograph of the candidate if desired) in support of the candidature. Such statement (together with any photograph) must not exceed 200 words and should be submitted as a doc or docx file to taselections@aec.gov.au. Candidates will be required to sign a declaration taking responsibility for the accuracy of the information contained in their statements.

The postal ballot, if required, will open on Thursday 31 August 2017 and close at 5pm on Monday 25 September 2017.
