As an elector in the Division of Stirling, with an interest in the industrial area of Osborne Park, I wish to make the following submission to the Redistribution Committee.


"That the area bounded by King Edward Road, Scarborough Beach Road and the Mitchell Freeway, known as part of the Osborne Park Industrial Area, currently contained within the Division of Curtin, be included as part of the Division of Stirling."

Points to consider:

- The area is industrial, and includes just 198 electors.
- Scarborough Beach Road and the Mitchell Freeway constitute a natural boundary between the two Divisions.
- There is a strong community of interest here in that this industrial area, coupled with several surrounding areas in Osborne Park and Balcatta, are represented at a business level by the Stirling Business Association, (SBA), formerly the Osborne Park Balcatta Business Association, (OPBBA), and would be best represented federally by one Federal member.
- The area is part of the City of Stirling, which covers most of the Division of Stirling, and is represented at Council level by Councillors, the remainder of whose ward is entirely within the Division of Stirling.
- It is part of the State seat of Innaloo, the remainder of which is also within the Division of Stirling.
- The area is serviced by the Community Newspaper *The Stirling Times*, which is delivered throughout the Stirling Division, and is yet another example of community of interest.

I hope that these points may help you to consider this submission with some degree of favour.
