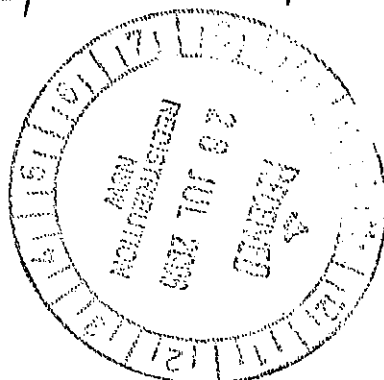
Dear Sirs,
