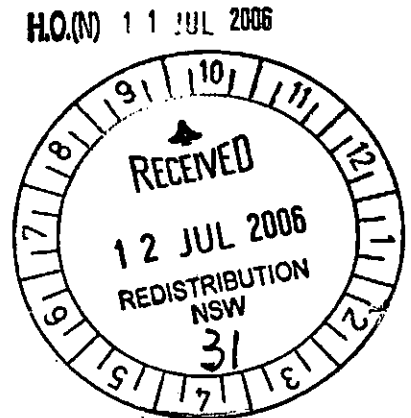

Re: electoral re distribution N.S.W.



I do not see how the proposed re distribution of boundaries west of the Great Dividing Range is appropriate to us the electorate.

Some established electorates are proposed to be divided- often towns divided in half- is not appropriate for the people concerned. The member of parliament is disrupted in their representation of the electorate –**that's we the people.**

We have very large areas as electorates as it is, creating divisions of towns is a way of dividing and –looks to me like your trying to concur.

I am told you're an independent advisers, thou I fail to see why one of the major independent members, Peter Andre electorate is so adversely affected ?

You are advisers to the government, on recent experience I doubt this independence. The proposed boundaries –seem to adversely affect the independent sitting members.

I agree with the proposal that the slight re distribution of a city electorate would cause less trouble – as city electorates have a greater concentration of people. Suburbs of city areas have greater similarities to each other. Whereas country towns often have familiarity and similarities that are not easily developed.
