

## Redistribution 2008

### Western Australia Quota Information

In accordance with Section 65 of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918*, the Electoral Commissioner has determined the quota of electors for the purpose of the redistribution of Western Australia to be **88,192** which has been calculated as follows:

Number of Members of the House of Representatives to which Western Australia is entitled	15
Number of electors enrolled in Western Australia at the end of the day on which the redistribution commenced (14 December 2007)	1,322,878
Quota for the State	<b>88,192</b>
Permissible maximum number of electors in a Division (Quota + 10%)	97,011
Permissible minimum number of electors in a division (Quota - 10%)	79,373

For the purposes of Section 66(3) of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918*, the following figures will apply:
