

Dear Sir

I write to express mine and my Council's strong belief that the Tumbarumba Shire Council should remain as part of the Eden-Monaro electorate in your upcoming electoral seat redistribution review. My Council has developed and encouraged significant relationships and involvement with many of the regional population centres within the seat together with our neighbouring Shire, Tumut Shire Council, and any separation and/or removal from the seat of Eden-Monaro would be extremely detrimental to our Shire residents and community in general.

Council also has concerns in regards to the potential loss of a rural seat when the practical equality of being able to service some of the large sized inland area rural seats in this nation is becoming physically impossible for our many hard-working rural parliamentarians.
