Dear Sirs

My husband & I wish to object strongly to the proposed redistribution whereby we Neutral Bay voters are to be moved from the North Sydney Electorate to the Warringah Electorate. We believe we have more community & regional interests with Cammeray, Milson's Point & Cross Rest than with the voters of Warringah.

Other points to note are: —

1. North Sydney is a Federation seat & should be preserved
2. It is unnecessary moving the seat out of its traditional area.
3. Taking 14,000 seats out of Neutral Bay to Warringah & 14,000 out of the northern part of Warringah to North Sydney is unnecessarily disrupting 28,000 voters.

4. This transfer is unnecessary as barrington can remain where it is with only a minor transfer of votes.
5. Community of Interest basis:- Neutral Bay school is the largest voting booth in North Sydney for Federal, State & local elections, hence more disruption.
6. This proposed re-distribution is a blatant disregard of the statutory requirement to keep a Community of Interest whenever possible.
7. There would be almost no access to the local member whose office is in Randly.
