Dear Sir,

I object to the proposed redistribution of voters between the North Sydney and Warringah electorates, which would shift me from the former to the latter. It is inconceivable that it is considered that I would have more community interest, more in common, with beachside suburbs like Manly, Dee Why and Curl Curl than I do with other near city areas such as North Sydney, Cammeray, Waverton, Kirribilli, Wollstonecraft and McMahon's Point. The proposed new western boundary of North Sydney, the Warringah Freeway, is not a natural feature, and its partial use, until it turns westward, is clearly a matter of convenience, not consistency.

I suggest that the proposed redistribution be rejected. While no change might be the most obvious and simple solution, a thorough redistribution that placed all the northern harbourside suburbs from Mosman to, say, the Gladesville Bridge would be more sensible.
