Dear Sirs/Ms.

This will formally lodge our strongest possible objection to the proposed electoral redistribution involving Neutral bay and Cremorne residents being transferred into the electorate of Warringah.

Neutral bay and Cremorne residents have absolutely no community affinity with Warringah. We all live within a short distance from the centre of North Sydney CBD and clearly identify with the Sydney Harbour Bridge and the North Sydney local government area.

To base this on the premise that the residents of Neutral bay and Cremorne have more community and regional interest with voters from Manly Vale, Allambie, Brookvale etc is fallacious to the extreme and should be perfectly and obviously apparent to anyone with any knowledge of the area. In fact we have no interest or desire to be transferred into the electorate of Warringah.

Residents of Neutral Bay and Cremorne are proud to be part of a diverse and growing community in its present form; growing as a result of higher density of living developments.

Also, why it is proposed that the local government area of North Sydney should be carved up is flawed as it is unnatural and illogical. The proposed new boundaries creates an artificial electorate that fails the test of uniting communities with common interests. The concept of the residents of Neutral Bay and Cremorne having a united and common interest with Warringah is ridiculous and shows flawed judgement as to the differences between these areas.
