SUGGESTION TO NEW SOUTH WALES REDISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE 2009

SUGGESTION TO THE REDISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DIVISION OF NEW SOUTH WALES INTO 48 FEDERAL ELECTORAL DIVISIONS.

- Barely three years after the most recent redistribution of Federal electoral boundaries in New South Wales resulted in the abolition of an electorate, population statistics again show that NSW should lose one of its electoral divisions (notionally, to Queensland) prior to the next Federal election.
- 2. As the 3.5-year projection date of the 2006 Redistribution will now not be reached during the life of this distribution, population growth among the existing divisions appears more random and inconsistent than it might otherwise have appeared over the full 7-year cycle. Consequently, no single area of the State stands out as deserving of being targeted for reduction in terms of divisional representation (as the Far North of New South Wales did in 2006).
- 3. This suggestion deals with the whole of the State of New South Wales (even though I have never personally travelled to many areas in the north of the State), as I believe that region-specific approaches ignore the Redistribution Committee's obligations in respect of other regions.
- 4. In compiling this suggestion, however, I am acting upon two key beliefs regarding the optimum direction of this exercise.

- 5. I believe it is absolutely essential for the continued good standing of the Australian Electoral Commission in rural New South Wales that the Divisions of Calare, Farrer, Hume, Macquarie, New England, Parkes and Riverina are retained.
- 6. I also believe it is imperative that an electoral division is created based upon the burgeoning developmental areas of Riverstone and Rouse Hill in Sydney's north-western suburbs these areas being among the most rapidly-expanding areas in the nation.
- 7. Some key features of this suggestion include: -
 - The absence of a division named *Eden-Monaro*;
 - The absence of a division named Berowra;
 - The proposal of a new division based on Riverstone and Rouse Hill (as above) and named McMahon;
 - Ten (10) divisions retaining essentially unchanged boundaries;
 - A further eight (8) divisions requiring only minimal change to boundaries (with "minimal change" being defined as the transfer of electors through the addition and/or subtraction of a single Local Government Area (LGA), or part of a single LGA); and
 - The re-unification of thirteen (13) LGAs previously split between more than one Federal Electorate.

NORTH COAST

- 8. I propose that the existing boundaries of the Divisions of Richmond, Page and Cowper remain unchanged; and
- 9. That the Division of *Lyne* acquire the Gloucester LGA from Paterson, this being sufficient to ensure that projected tolerances for the division are met. Any additional alteration of the boundaries of the North Coast electorates is neither desirable nor even necessary.
- 10. Further to recent public comments attributed to the current Member for *Lyne*, I also propose that the name of this Division remain unchanged.

REMOTE COUNTRY

- 11. As it is clear that the current boundaries of the Division of New England do not need substantial adjustment, I propose only that the remainder of the Gwydir Shire be transferred from the Division of Parkes.
- 12. I then propose that the Division of *Parkes* acquire the Bourke, Brewarrina, Narromine and Warren LGAs from the existing Division of Calare these areas having long histories of inclusion in the Divisions of Parkes and Gwydir.
- 13. I also notice that nine (9) electors in the Upper Hunter LGA and 41 electors from the Lithgow LGA have been 'orphaned' in *Parkes*, and I propose that they be united with the rest of their LGA populations in the Divisions of Hunter and Macquarie respectively.

- 14. In order for other divisions to fit within current and projected tolerances, the Division of *Calare* must shed the Bourke, Brewarrina, Narromine and Warren LGAs to Parkes, as well as its component of the Bathurst Regional LGA to Macquarie. To compensate for this, I propose that *Calare* acquires the Bland LGA (from Riverina) and the remainder of the Central Darling LGA plus the City of Broken Hill and the Unincorporated Far West (from Farrer).
- 15. After these alterations, the Divisions of Calare and Parkes will still be geographically vast and diverse electorates. However, I am confident that they will be as manageable as the Australian Electoral Commission can possibly make them under the parameters of current legislation.
- 16. After shedding the Bland LGA, I propose that the Division of *Riverina* acquire the Balranald, Hay and Wentworth LGAs from the Division of Farrer. The Hay LGA has a very long history of inclusion in *Riverina*, and the economies of the other communities rely strongly on the same irrigated agricultural base that sustains the majority of the existing division.
- 17. Another feature of recommendation for this proposed division is that it would contain virtually the entire length of the Sturt Highway in New South Wales (with the exception of a brief section traversing the Wakool LGA).

- 18. Without question or qualification, I can describe the inclusion of Broken Hill and the Unincorporated Far West in the existing Division of *Farrer* as the most ghastly blunder ever perpetrated upon the electors of these areas by the AEC. *Farrer* must shed these areas, and Calare is the most logical option given the high population in the major centres of Riverina and the current eastward extension of Parkes.
- 19. Farrer also loses the Balranald, Hay and Wentworth LGAs to Riverina, so the input of a significant number of electors from areas to the west of the existing division is required in order for the division to conform to tolerances. As there is only one division from which these electors can be sourced, I propose that the Bombala, Cooma-Monaro, Snowy River, Tumbarumba and Tumut LGAs all be transferred across from Eden-Monaro.
- 20. The major benefit of this proposed transfer would be the inclusion of Australia's High Country and Alpine regions in the same electorate as most of New South Wales' Murray River border area.
- 21. Significant infrastructure development throughout the Australian Alps over the last half-century has critically impacted upon the quality and level of flow along the Murray's course through southern NSW. Although the Bombala, Cooma-Monaro and Snowy River LGAs have remained in Eden-Monaro since Federation, it would be entirely appropriate for the areas containing the Murray's source to be included in *Farrer*.

- 22. Finally, I am including the Division of Hume as "Remote Country", as I propose that the division should focus more clearly on the Southern Tablelands through the transfer of its part of the Wollondilly LGA to the Division of Macarthur.
- 23. After losing this area, *Hume* must gain electors to the south or east, and I propose that the division acquire around 15,500 electors from the north western areas of the Shoalhaven LGA.
- 24. I have unfortunately been prevented from travelling to Sydney to access the AEC's Mapmaker facilities, and so I have had to base this suggestion around very rough percentile calculations, but I believe that *Hume* would have to acquire around 35% of Shoalhaven (Part B) electors from the existing Division of Gilmore. I trust the Redistribution Committee will understand my intention.

SOUTH COAST & SOUTHERN METROPOLITAN

25. After losing five (5) LGAs to Farrer, the Division of Eden-Monaro is vastly reduced in area and includes only the Far South Coast and greater Queanbeyan. Even after allowing for the re-unification of the Eurobodalla LGA in this division, around 13,300 Shoalhaven (Part B) electors will also be required in order to ensure that the division fits within acceptable tolerance levels.

- 26. However, with the majority of the Monaro region transferred away, "Eden-Monaro" is no longer suitable for continued use as a division name in this area. I therefore propose that the name be dispensed with, and that this division instead carry the name *Gilmore*.
- 27. These changes leave the Kiama and Shellharbour LGAs, and the remainder of the Shoalhaven LGA, to be combined in one division under the name *Throsby*.
- 28. The existing Division of Throsby loses its part of the Wollongong LGA to the Division of *Cunningham*, which should then be able to retain approximately 56,000 electors from the southernmost areas of its own Wollongong component.
- 29. The remainder of the City of Wollongong the northern part of the LGA containing around 36,000 electors is transferred to the Division of *Hughes*, which loses its existing Liverpool LGA component to the Division of Banks in order to accommodate this.
- 30. Additionally, I propose that the small part of the Wollondilly LGA from the north of the existing Division of Cunningham be transferred to the Division of Macarthur; and
- 31. I propose that the existing boundaries of the Division of *Cook* remain unchanged.

INNER METROPOLITAN

- 32. I propose that the existing boundaries of the Divisions of *Kingsford Smith* and *Wentworth* remain unchanged.
- 33. The Division of *Sydney* requires minimal change, but I would propose the transfer of approximately 4800 electors from the Leichhardt LGA component of the existing Division of Grayndler.
- 34. I then propose that the remainder of Grayndler's existing Leichhardt LGA component, plus the northernmost 14,500 electors from the existing division's part of the Ashfield LGA, be transferred to the Division of *Lowe*. This change will allow *Lowe* to be configured more clearly as a waterfront division with adjacent landlocked service centres.
- 35. In order to accommodate these changes, *Lowe* loses its part of the Canterbury LGA (to Grayndler), plus 6600 electors from the Burwood LGA and 9200 electors from its part of the Strathfield LGA (to Blaxland).
- 36. The Division of *Grayndler* additionally accepts approximately 28,000 electors from that part of the Canterbury LGA in the existing Division of Watson.
- 37. The Division of *Watson* shifts sharply to the south and is configured similarly to the old Division of St George (from where the current division was derived in 1992). It acquires around 60 electors in the Canterbury LGA from Blaxland and the remainder of the Hurstville LGA from Banks.

- 38. Despite shedding such a large number of electors to Grayndler, Watson must still lose more voters in order to remain within projected tolerances. For that reason, I propose that it lose its part of the Rockdale LGA to the Division of *Barton*, which otherwise remains unchanged.
- 39. My proposed Division of Blaxland retains Bankstown as its central focus area, but shifts to the east by acquiring more Strathfield electors and around one-third of all Burwood electors from the Division of Lowe. It then loses its part of the Holroyd LGA and approximately 8400 electors from its Fairfield East component to the Division of Prospect.
- 40. The Division of Banks shifts noticeably towards Sydney's South Western corridor, acquiring that part of the Liverpool LGA in the existing Division of Hughes while losing its part of the Hurstville LGA to the Division of Watson. [I believe this proposed Bankstown-Liverpool division makes infinitely more sense than the existing Sutherland-Liverpool Division of Hughes. See paragraph 29.]
- 41. The Division of *Reid* must lose a small number of electors in order to remain with tolerances at projection time, and so I propose that it shed its Parramatta North East component to the Division of Parramatta.

SOUTH WEST & OUTER WEST METROPOLITAN

- 42. I propose that the major focus area of the Division of *Macarthur* be shifted from metropolitan Campbelltown to the faster-growing Southern Highlands region through the acquisition of the remainder of the Wollondilly LGA from the Divisions of Cunningham, Fowler, Hume and Macquarie.
- 43. I also propose that the Camden LGA be united in *Macarthur*, and that the Liverpool West and Penrith East components of the existing Division of Fowler be transferred to this division as well.
- 44. I propose that Macarthur lose its part of the Campbelltown LGA to *Werriwa*, with this change allowing the City of Campbelltown to be self-contained within *Werriwa* in the same way that the Victorian City of Darebin is currently self-contained within the Division of Batman.
- 45. Werriwa's existing Liverpool LGA component is transferred to the Division of *Fowler*, which retains its own Liverpool East and Fairfield West components as well as approximately 9600 electors from its existing Fairfield East component (the remaining 6400 electors from this area being transferred to Prospect).
- 46. I propose that the Division of *Prospect* also move eastwards by losing its existing part of the Penrith LGA (to Lindsay) but acquiring around 14,800 Fairfield East electors from Blaxland and Fowler. *Prospect* also acquires the existing Holroyd LGA component of the Division of Blaxland, and retains its own Blacktown LGA component (which includes the Prospect Reservoir).

- 47. The Division of *Lindsay* gains nearly 19,000 electors in the south eastern corner of the Penrith LGA from Prospect, and so must shed approximately 14,800 electors from the northern part of the existing division to Greenway (enlarging Greenway's Penrith component and allowing for significant modification of the eastern part of its Blacktown component).
- 48. I propose that Local Government boundaries play a greater role in the configuration of the Division of *Macquarie*, with the division losing its small parts of the Hawkesbury and Wollondilly LGAs (to Greenway and Macarthur respectively) and gaining the remainder of the Bathurst Regional LGA from Calare.

NORTH WEST & NORTHERN METROPOLITAN

- 49. My proposal for *Greenway* involves the division increasing its Penrith component while reducing its existing Blacktown component. The division acquires 14,800 electors from the north of the division of Lindsay, while just over 20,000 electors from the north of the City of Blacktown are lost to a neighbouring division to the east (see paragraphs 6 and 53).
- 50. I also propose that *Greenway* acquire the Baulkham Hills North component of the existing Division of Berowra; and
- 51. I propose that the existing boundaries of the Division of *Chifley* remain unchanged.

- 52. As stated earlier, I believe it is imperative that a Federal electoral division be established around the key growth areas of Sydney's north western corridor in Riverstone and Rouse Hill. With all due respect and deference to the local knowledge and expertise of the members of the Redistribution Committee, I submit that such a division could be easily arranged.
- 53. I propose that this division would contain around 20,500 electors from the Blacktown North component of the existing Division of Greenway. I would intend that this included the localities of Riverstone and Quakers Hill.
- 54. The division should also contain the Blacktown North and Baulkham Hills Central components of the existing Division of Parramatta, and the Baulkham Hills North and Parramatta North West components of the existing Division of Mitchell. My intention here is to include Rouse Hill and most of the locality of Baulkham Hills.
- 55. Approximately 32,300 electors from the Baulkham Hills Central component of the existing Division of Mitchell will also be required for this division, but otherwise my intention is that Mitchell retains Castle Hill along with its existing Hornsby component.
- 56. I propose that this division carry the name *McMahon* after Sir William McMahon (1908-88), Member of the House of Representatives 1949-82; Minister of the Crown various portfolios including Treasury and Foreign Affairs 1951-71; Prime Minister of Australia 1971-72. Sir William is currently the only deceased ex-Prime Minister not to have had a Federal Electorate named in his honour.

- 57. While the Division of *Parramatta* loses its Blacktown North and Baulkham Hills Central components to this division, I propose that it gain the Parramatta North East component of the existing Division of Reid by way of compensation (see paragraph 40).
- 58. The Division of *Mitchell* provides the bulk of electors to McMahon, but I propose that around 69,000 electors from the south and west of the existing Division of Berowra be combined with those from Castle Hill and surrounding areas to form what is substantively another new division. As the locality of Berowra would not be included in this division, I propose it carry the name *Mitchell*.
- 59. In fact, my ultimate intention is that the locality of Berowra be transferred to Robertson (see paragraph 64). As a consequence of this, the name "Berowra" becomes unsuitable for continued divisional use and is dispensed with.
- 60. The Division of *Mackellar* requires only minimal change to ensure that it fits within required tolerances at projection time. However, instead of altering the boundaries of Warringah unnecessarily (see paragraph 63), I propose that approximately 3400 electors from the St Ives area be transferred from Bradfield instead.
- 61. The Division of *Bradfield* then acquires another 2100 Hornsby North electors from neighbouring areas of the existing Division of Berowra.

- 62. I propose that the existing boundaries of the Division of Bennelong remain essentially unchanged, except for the addition of two 'orphaned' Ryde CCDs from Lowe and Reid (which would not involve the transfer of any electors); and
- 63. That the existing boundaries of the Divisions of *North Sydney* and *Warringah* remain unchanged.

CENTRAL COAST & HUNTER

- 64. Owing to the proposed abolition of the Division of Berowra, the Division of *Robertson* must extend into and include the northern suburbs of the Hornsby LGA (including the locality of Berowra). From my calculations, approximately 14,700 electors from the north eastern areas of the Hornsby LGA must be accepted into *Robertson*.
- 65. To accommodate this, Robertson loses around 24,000 electors from its existing Gosford East component to the Division of *Dobell*, but also gains the entire Gosford West component of that division. As a consequence of this, *Dobell* loses a further 10,000 Wyong North East electors to the Division of Shortland.
- 66. Only minor adjustments are required for the remaining divisions in New South Wales, with *Shortland* passing approximately 8500 Lake Macquarie North electors on to the Division of Newcastle.

- 67. The Division of *Charlton* picks up approximately 2500 electors from Newcastle's outer western regions while losing 400 others from the southern districts of that city.
- 68. The Division of *Hunter* remains essentially unchanged with the exception of the addition of the nine (9) 'orphaned' Upper Hunter electors from the Division of Parkes and the transfer of an elector-free Liverpool Plains CCD to New England.
- 69. After accepting the surplus electors from the north of the Division of Shortland, the Division of *Newcastle* must still reduce its Maitland component despite also ceding electors from the city's outer western suburbs to Charlton.
- 70. Around 4000 electors from the south east of the Maitland LGA must be transferred to the Division of *Paterson*, with these electors compensating for the loss of the Gloucester LGA from that division to Lyne.

CONCLUSION

- 71. I believe this suggestion offers a more equitable solution to the question of the arrangement of Federal electoral boundaries in New South Wales than currently exists.
- 72. Despite substantial changes in some areas, only 18.87% of current electors at 19/2/2009 will be transferred to a new division an excellent result given my suggestion calls for two (2) existing electorates to be abolished.
- 73. I wish the Redistribution Committee the best of fortune in its deliberations.
