

We wish to support the nomination of the name of the late Mr Len Waters for the new Federal Electoral seat in Queensland.

I was the police prosecutor for the Western Suburbs Magistrates' Court at Inala from 1978 to 1981 and came to know Len well as his wife Gladys worked in the police establishment. Len always acted as a reliable, trusty and loyal member of the community and a true Australian. I knew him to be the first Aboriginal fighter pilot in the RAAF and he was doubly proud to be an aboriginal and an Australian service man and to have served his country.

His memory is deserving of such an honor and I believe all of the local Inala people as well as those in St George and in New South Wales would deem it a privilege to have know Len and see his name recognized as a Federal Electoral seat especially in Queensland.

At Inala, I was a sergeant 2/c of police and rose to the rank of Superintendent of Police in Rockhampton when I retired in 1993 and I still keep in touch with Len's wife Gladys. My wife Fay has signed her name in support of this proposal.
