



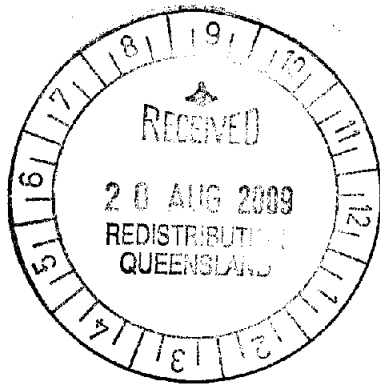

Dear Sir,

I wish to lodge an objection to the proposed re-distribution of the electoral boundaries of the electorate of Lilley in Queensland.

My objection is based on the proposed changes to the northern boundaries which presently include the suburbs of Sandgate, Brighton, Shorncliffe and Deagon. All of these suburbs have been traditionally associated with the activities and political changes which effect the north Brisbane area.

It would in my opinion disadvantage enormously the citizens in these areas to have their political representative based in the less geographical and population centre of the proposed Petrie electorate. Historically there has never been any direct linkage with the Petrie electorate. The natural boundaries of the Pine River has made the existing boundary well defined and served the population well.
