To Whom It May Concern

I wish to voice my objection to the redistribution of Lilley and Petrie to incorporate the suburbs of Shorncliffe, Sandgate, Brighton and Deagon into Petrie from Lilley.

The proposed electorate of Petrie will be a disjointed, fractured electorate with several parts that have nothing in common with eachother. For example, the redcliffe peninsular and the suburbs of Sandgate, Deagon, Brighton and Shorncliffe are two very distinct and seperate communities, with very different histories, as does Northlakes. I feel these communities are too incompatible to be unilaterally lumped together.

The electorate of Lilley has a largely homogenous community and is easily identifyable as something that belongs together. To break this up and place residents of Sandgate, Redcliffe, Deception Bay, Northlakes together will create a community that does not function.
