### **Objection to the Proposed Boundary Change for the Division of Dickson, QLD**

Siting the AEC's own parameters for the boundary changes such as 'community of interests, communication and transport links, physical features' why then would the AEC be looking at splitting our district of Dayboro in half along the North Pine River and not the other natural boundary of the Daguilar Range?

Dayboro, encompassing all of it's individual localities including Ocean View, Kings Scrub, Rush Creek, Laceys Creek, Armstrong Creek, Mt Pleasant, Samsonvale and the Dayboro Township, are a very close knit community that deal mainly with the Strathpine area which is the centre of the Dickson electorate and not Caboolture where the seat of Longman is administered from.


Our limited public transport takes us east to Strathpine, not north to Caboolture and most of our students go to high schools in that area.
