The appointment takes a few days to be available to AEC Returning Officers throughout Australia, so it should be lodged with the AEC, using the details below, well before the close of nominations in an election.
- An appointment needs to be signed by both the Registered Officer making the appointment and the Deputy Registered Officer being appointed. An appointment can be revoked by letter by the Registered Officer.

- The information requested on this form is collected under the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* and only the name of the Deputy Registered Officer is made public.
