I wish to object to the redistribution of Lalor and Gellibrand.

The boundary is on one of our major roads in and out of Point Cook and is also the boundary of Hobson Bay and Wyndham City Councils. This makes quite clear boundaries for both Local and a federal level.

To change these boundaries to the proposed ones, they would effectively mean that Point Cook as a suburb would be split in two and be dealing with 2 MP's rather than one.

We struggle with growth issues and have to deal with them on a daily basis. A split may effectively turn Point Cook into a ,”have and have not,” suburb.
