To whom it may concern.

I would like to submit the following objection to the proposed electoral boundary and name change to the **Corangamite** federal electoral division

In particular, it is my strong view that:-

- All of the Colac Otway Shire should remain in the electorate. There is a strong connection between Colac and Geelong as well as between Colac and Winchelsea, Colac and Apollo Bay and Colac and Birregurra. Removing Colac from the electorate would isolate it from many organisations and communities it services and receives services from, particularly in the agricultural, tourism, health and education sectors.
- Colac and the immediate areas around the town have little connection with the towns of Warrnambool & Hamilton and the other regions in the **Wannon** electorate.
- A large part of urban Geelong has been removed from the Corangamite electorate. The electorate's very nature is associated with its diverse mix of coastal and farming communities, national parks and lakes and the cities of Colac and Geelong.
- Corangamite is a federation seat. The proposed name "Cox" while a noble suggestion, has little relevance and significance to the people of the electorate.
 Maintaining the aboriginal heritage and history of this name is very important. If the Corangamite name must be changed, there are far more appropriate names which could be used.
