To whom it may concern,

I wish to lodge my objection to the redistribution of the Dunkley electoral boundary and, in particular, the exclusion of the Mornington community in the proposed redistribution.

The communities of Mornington, Mt Eliza and Frankston are intrinsically linked; parents work and socialise across all three townships and families use sporting, school, health and shopping facilities interchangeably. These townships and communities are very much linked, with much commonality both geographically and socio-econmically.

For these reasons, I oppose the township of Mornington being 'split-off' from the Dunkley electorate (and absorbed into the Flinders electorate) and urge the AEC to reconsider the boundary re-alignment.
