Objection to the Victorian Federal Redistribution – Aston/Bruce

The Rowville Football Club objects to the proposed Victorian Federal redistribution which would place our ground and clubhouse at Seebeck Oval, Stud Road Rowville in the electorate of Bruce.

We are a very large community club, established in 1965 with over 300 boys and girls playing in our junior teams. Our senior teams compete in Division 1 of the Eastern Football League.

The proposed new boundary along Police Road (near the intersection of Stud Road) would completely isolate our ground and facilities on a political basis from the families that form our community.

We believe that approximately 90% of our members live in the electorate of Aston and have no connection at all on a political basis with the electorate of Bruce.

Over the years we have developed strong relationships with our local members and we are hoping that we will continue to do this because it is the member for Aston that represents our families and members.

We wish to stress that our club, our members and Seebeck Oval on Stud Road Rowville has no connection whatsoever with the electorate of Bruce.

We therefore wish to remain in the electorate of Aston.

Furthermore, we believe that the Rowville Cricket Club that shares Seebeck Oval supports our objection on similar grounds.
