As a registered voter in the Federal Electorate of Corangamite can I register my objection to the redistribution of boundary proposed for this electorate.

This move to exclude Colac and Districts from the current electorate will change the economic and social fabric of the region. Most communication and travel is centred on Geelong as a regional centre not Hamilton - the newly upgraded Princes Highway between Geelong and Colac is testament to this fact — community interest is best served by the current electoral system

This new proposed distribution will spit Colac Otway Shire in two parts, resulting in the Local Government

(Colac Otway Shire) having to negotiate for funding and services with 2 separate Federal politicians

I also oppose the name change to the electorate:
