# Re Application to change party secretary for the Australian Democrats

On 19 December 2012, the Australian Electoral Commission (the AEC) received the attached application to record a change in the National Secretary of the Australian Democrats (the Party) from Mr Roger Howe to you.

The secretary of a registered political party is a significant position defined in s.123 of the Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918 (the Electoral Act) with a specific role as:

the person who holds the office (however described) the duties of which involve responsibility for the carrying out of the administration, and for the conduct of the correspondence, of the party.

The secretary is required under the Electoral Act to sign some applications, is expected to be the source of general correspondence from the Party and is the person to whom the AEC directs correspondence other than items which must be sent to the Party's registered officer.

Because of the importance of the position of secretary in a registered political party, the AEC expects applications to record a change in secretary to come from office bearers known to and already recorded with the AEC. In instances where that is not the case, such as the attached application, the AEC seeks clarification of the Party's change in secretary to ensure that such a change has been made in accordance with the Party's constitution. If there is conflict between factions in a party, the AEC wants to hear from relevant factions before determining which person it should record as the party's secretary.

As you appear to be the new National Secretary of the Australian Democrats, could you please provide the AEC with evidence of the change made by the Party? Such evidence would include signed minutes of the meeting which elected/appointed you plus the arrangements for notifying members or committee members in advance of the calling of that meeting.

The AEC will be closed from 25 December 2012 to 1 January 2013 inclusive. Obviously many people including office holders in your Party will also be taking leave around this time. Perhaps if you could respond with the required evidence by Friday 18 January 2013, or alternatively advise the AEC of a more suitable date if that is not convenient.
