Scheduled Election

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Nominations are called for:

- Federal Secretary (1)
- Assistant Federal Secretary (1)

Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 9:00am Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) 16/01/2019.

A candidate shall have been a financial member of the Federation for a period of two years immediately preceding the date of nomination for office.

Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00 noon Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) **on** 30/01/2019.

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00 noon Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) on 30/01/2019.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit to the Returning Officer a statement (**up to 200 words**) (together with a photograph of the candidate if desired) to be included with ballot material. Such statement shall not exceed two hundred words.

Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00 noon (Local Time (office of the Returning Officer)) on 07/02/2019 can be accepted.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 20/02/2019 and close at 5:00pm Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) on 13/03/2019.

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers opens 9:00am Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) on 16/01/2019 and closes 9:00am Local Time (office of the Returning Officer) on 14/03/2019.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
