Description	To successfully deliver a federal election the AEC employs more than 100,000 people to form our Temporary Election Workforce (TEW). The AEC cannot deliver an election without the TEW.
	The AEC requires a contemporary and agile payroll solution that provides the capability to calculate and process payroll (including super and tax liabilities) so that TEW staff are paid in a timely manner according to their role and entitlements.
	The AEC must have a fully implemented and functional payroll solution before an election is likely to be called. Noting that federal elections do not have a fixed date, any delay to the full implementation of a solution is likely to pose a significant risk to election delivery.
