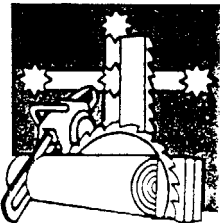

Dear Committee

I write in relation to the proposal to alter boundaries and put forward the view that if boundaries are to be adjusted, the following should be considered.

Lyons and Braddon - Being a past West Coast worker, I would strongly support the West Coast remaining in the Lyons boundary as this is certainly not a growth area - the fact is, it has diminished. Thus I would suggest that if there is a need to remove an area from Lyons, it should be near the Port Sorell/Wesley Vale/Latrobe and Mt Roland area.

Bass - If an adjustment is to be done between Bass and Lyons, we would support the extension of Bass down the Tamar River, as it is commonsense for the economic zone of the Tamar being covered by one electorate. Thus it could well be that Bass could penetrate down the Tamar and use the Asbestos Ranges as a dividing line with Braddon and Port Sorell.

I trust that these views will be given consideration.
