

Moreton Electorate

I strongly object to the new boundaries
which will exclude that part of
Yeronga bounded by Fairfield Rd,
Ortive St and the Brisbane River.

My objections are as follows.

- 1 There has been almost complete
lack of notification of the proposed
changes, to local residents.
- 2 The notice in the 'Courier Mail' was
~~printed~~ badly and so small, even
with a magnifying glass, the
boundaries were practically undefinable.
- 3 Residents should have been
advised by mail, of the proposed
changes

- 4 Many Yeronga residents have resided in the electorate for a great many years and have a good, strong and established attachment to Moreton.
- 5 If the area is split into two there will be dissatisfaction, dislocation and confusion in the community.
- 6 The interests and concerns of the community are not focused the inner city, either environmentally nor commercially.

I strongly urge you to urgently review the new boundaries between Moreton & Griffith.

1 Existing boundaries to remain unchanged.

2 New boundary to follow Ebebin Rd Ipswich Rd, Venner Rd, Fairfield Rd and Princess St.

or

Ebebin, Ipswich, Venner and Banskdale to the Brisbane

River
