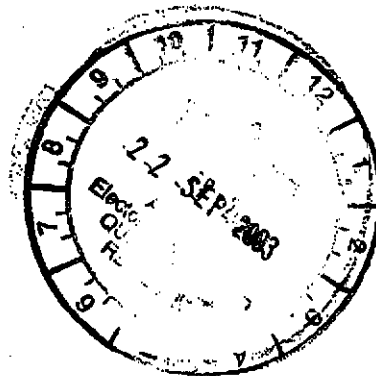
We, the undersigned electors of the Moreton Electorate, object to the proposed redistribution of portion of the Moreton Electorate for the following reasons:
