Dear Sir/Madam,

I live in the largest growth corridor in South East Queensland.

My community stretches down the Motorway from established suburban areas through to newer developments. We access service like shopping and schooling in suburban areas and we feel part of a suburban community.

Currently, however our community is split. It is divided into a number of Federal seats which encompass communities of interest that are no more. Many of us live in Forde which is a semi rural seat. It covers Beenleigh and Beaudesert and farming communities in between. It does not relate to our suburban lifestyle and it is inconceivable that people from Beenleigh, Ormeau, Kingsholme, Upper Coomera or the like would access any services in Jimboomba or Beaudesert.

Many people I have spoken to have moved here from Victoria and New South Wales. They did so because they wanted to have a suburban lifestyle with access to the Gold Coast. They chose our area because it was serviced by a Freeway, services along it in the form of shopping centres, medical centres and schools. They did not come here seeking a semi rural or rural existence.

The community we live in is almost entirely encapsulated in the Gold Coast City Council area. It makes sense that this should be taken into consideration when determining how our community will be represented. It unrealistic to expect our Federal representative to be able to represent an area slip across Council boundaries and split across clear demographic boundaries.

I urge the committee to consider these factors when redrafting the electoral boundaries. We ask that Forde be redrawn to encapsulate our community as outlined above and in the petition I have attached. I believe that if it is redrawn this way it will achieve two important objectives:

1. The unification of our community into 1 Federal District.
2. The recognition that the huge growth in our area needs to be consolidated into a District which is suburban and not rural.
