



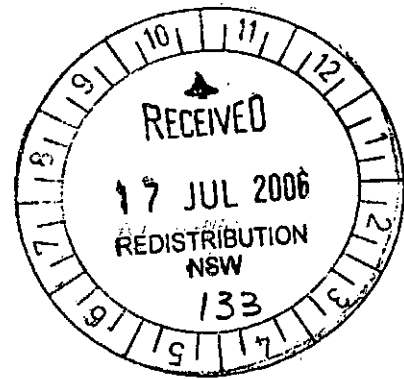

I would like to lodge my objection to the planed redistribution of the boundaries of the Parkes electorate.

The size of the proposed electorate, 370 474 sq klm, will be impossible for anyone to administer efficiently, let along address all the various issues from such a diversified range of primary products. e.g farming, grazing, mining, tourism, small business just to name a few,. The travelling involved would be very expensive, and time consuming. Should this representative be given a ministerial position, the problems would only multiply.

The proposed electorate covers 1/2 the state of NSW and should therefore have more than one person representing them in parliament.

The people of this vast area supply the majority of primary products produced in NSW and therefore bring in the majority of export income from those products. Should not they be entitled to more than one voice in parliament
