I write to strongly oppose the AEC's plan to abolish the Federal seat of Gwydir as part of the latest redistribution of NSW Federal electorates.

Although I realise that NSW must lose a seat to Queensland because of population changes, I really feel that there is no need at all to create this mega seat in NSW. The seat will be so big it will make it very hard for any Member to be readily available for constituents.

It will also make it extremely hard for a Member to be at a senior level in the government, where they can really give a powerful voice to rural concerns, and still look after the electorate.
