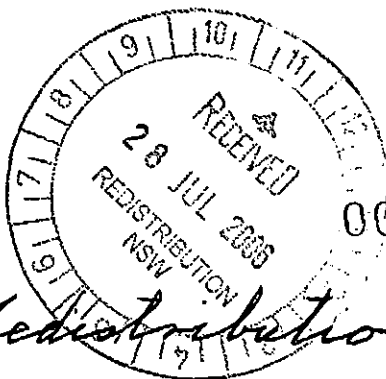

Dear Sirs,  
I am writing to lodge a strong objection to the proposed federal electoral redistribution of NSW which will result in the abolition of the seat of Gwydir. My reasons for objection are as follows,

1. The proposed new seat of Parkes which takes in approximately 47% of NSW is far to large for any elected member to adequately serve his/her constituents due to time spent travelling.
2. Access to any elected member in a seat of this proposed size will be extremely difficult
3. To create a seat which is 47% of the area of NSW will further reduce the voice of people west of the Great Dividing Ranges resulting in further reductions in facilities and services in the areas of healthcare, aged care, road and rail infrastructure.
