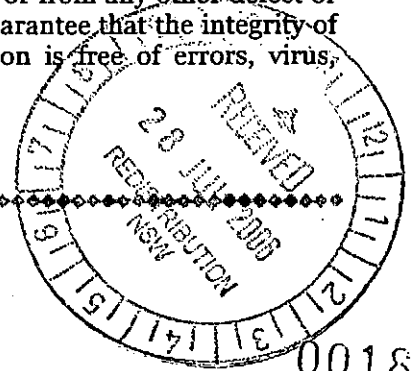
To the Electoral Commissioners,
