

Dear Sir,

I'd like to comment on the proposed electorate boundary changes.

As a resident of East Killara

I disagree with the proposed

change for the following reasons

1. The new areas to be included into the NEW Warringah (Roseville, East Lindfield, East Killara) have no natural connection with Warringah, divided by Middle Harbour.

2. Transport, particularly public transport between the proposed & current Warringah electorate is against the natural direction of this area's transport systems.

3. Stating that splitting Neutral Bay, Commeray & Cremorne was rejected due to them being in the same North Sydney Local Govt area is just plain silly.

There is at least a natural connection with these areas. And many residents living in the current Warringah pass through these areas regularly, making it a natural connection.

So what you currently propose is just a crazy idea. With no thought about about the PRACTICAL representation of the residents (voters) of East Killara, East Lindfield & Roseville area.
