I object strongly to my locality being moved out of the electorate of Eden-Monaro into Hume.

A more natural boundary to this population centre of Bungendore/Bywong/Wamboin is the Federal Highway and the southern shores of Lake George, rather than the chosen arbitrary boundary where everything west of the Kings Highway goes to Hume.

Also, everybody in the abovementioned areas works in Queanbeyan or Canberra, and should they wish to consult their local member, they would have to think twice about making a trip in the other direction to Goulburn.

Furthermore, should I wish to make any political affiliations or join a political party, it is more natural for me to do it in the township of Bungendore, which is a ten minute drive from my house. Under the new proposals, Bungendore and my home would be in two different electorates.
