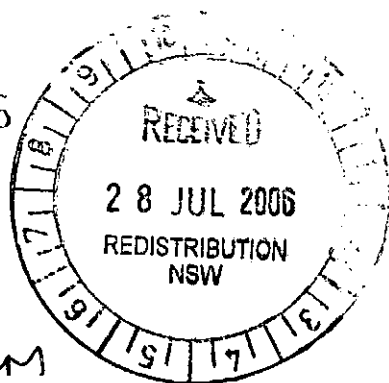

Dear Commissioners,

We are writing this letter to you with regards to the proposed changes to the Federal electorate of Cwydir.
