Subject Proposed redistribution for electorates of Page and Richmond

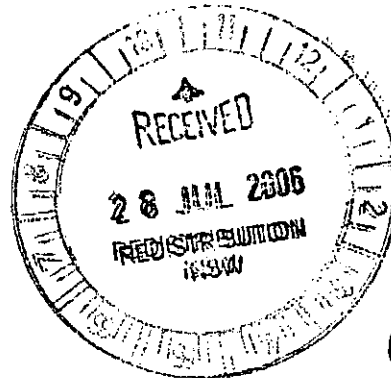

I wish to object to the proposed changes to the electorates of Page and Richmond.

I reside in Modanville which is 15 minutes from the centre of the Lismore CBD and is currently in the Page electorate. Under the proposed changes, Modanville would become part of the Richmond electorate. As the Richmond electorate is mainly comprised of communities closer to Byron and Tweed shires, I can't understand the sense of Modanville being a part of the Richmond electorate. We are located about 45 minutes from Byron Bay and 1 hour at least from Tweed. Surely, in view of Modanville being an outer community of Lismore, we should remain in the same electorate as Lismore. Our close neighbours at Tullera (only 5 minutes away) are to remain in Page and I believe Modanville should also remain in Page.
