



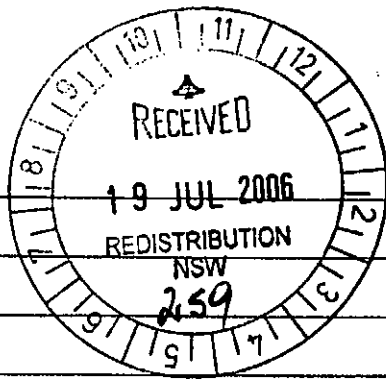

Dear Sirs,

I am writing this letter to your Committee to voice my very strong objection to the proposed redistribution of the Gwydir Electorate.

The reason for the smaller population of Gwydir is quite obvious. It is mainly a Farming & Grazing area, vital to the welfare of the people of New South Wales. No farming or grazing, no food produced.

The area that you have proposed is quite ludicrous. Can you imagine any Member being able to efficiently represent his Electorate in an area covering some

38,000 square kilometres. By contrast the seat of Wentworth in Sydney is just a mere 26 square kilometres. That means the proposed Gwydir Electorate is 142615 times bigger than Wentworth. Surely no person with any common sense could expect one Member to adequately service such an area.

Finally I suggest that each Member of your Committee, individually drive out to Cameron's Corner in the far north-west of the proposed Electorate and then drive from there

To the North East corner beyond Moree
to the Queensland Border. This trip would
take you a minimum time of at least
14 hours.

I respectfully suggest that you
rethink this absurd Redistribution of funds.
