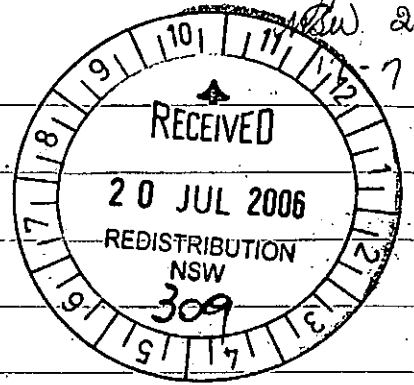

Dear Sirs,

I am writing to ask you to please reconsider the proposal to abolish the seat of Lyndrigh and merge the electorate into the seat of Parkes. Surely this is being unfair to the many constituents who reside in these rural areas.

To create an electorate which would comprise 45% of NSW would be totally impractical. How could a parliamentary representative be expected to look after his constituents covering such an area. Surely it would be far less disruptive and more equitable to abolish a Sydney electorate. Constituents here would probably be only 15 mins. from their MP's office whereas the rural folk would have to travel for many hours.

In the most recent NSW electoral redistribution the Commissioners were mindful of the huge size of the State seat of Murray-Darling and proceeded to reduce the size of that electorate. It's extremely hard to understand why in this current redistribution such a huge seat would be unnecessarily created.
