I wish to

lodge my disapproval of your  
decision to abolish the seat of  
Guydir and merge the electorate  
into the seat of Parkes.

This would mean that the new  
electorate of Parkes would be  
almost 380,000 square Kilometres  
in ~~size~~ size or 47 percent  
of N.S.Wales.

This proposal effectively

reduces the voice of country people in the Federal Parliament and make the seat of Parkes bigger than Japan & Germany and five times and a half bigger than Tasmania

The estimated growth rates provided by the Australian Electoral Commission do not predict Parkes or Gwydir to have a lower rate of growth.

It seems to me that the legislative requirements for communities of interest and the size of the electorates to be considered have been ignored in the redistribution.

Both the Liberals and the Nationals argue strongly that there is a case for the abolition of a Sydney Electorate.

This would cause far less disruption and be much more equitable than abolishing the Gwydir I remain a concerned Rural Voter. yours sincerely,
