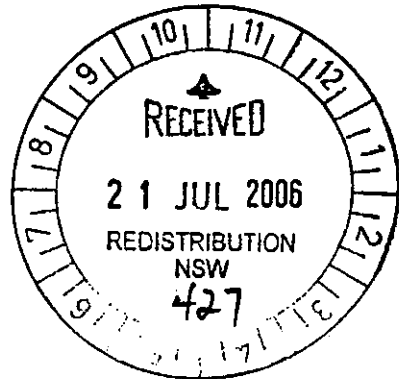

I write to register opposition to the proposed changes to electoral boundaries in New South Wales.

I find the proposed plan to eliminate the seat of Gwydir to be extremely detrimental to the constituents of the area. The need for access to Federal Government representation is ongoing. This is particularly so as country people are continually required to compete with their city counterparts for services. Our services are vital to the growth and maintenance of our areas.

I suggest that there is a case for the abolition of a Sydney electorate. This would cause far less disruption and be much more equitable than abolishing the Gwydir electorate.
