



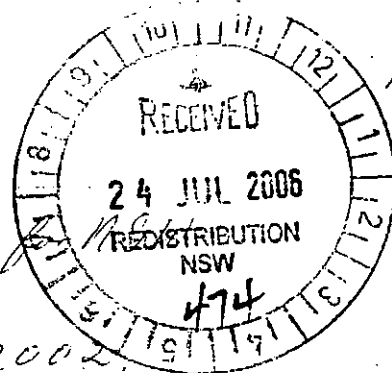

parliament.

restrict the Commission's ability to
work on anything but population &
if this is so, perhaps the Commission could
make a submission to Parliament proposing
changes that incorporate a loading for
productivity per head so that big &

² valuable industries are not left without sufficient representation to protect their interests.
