

Dear Sirs

I write to lodge my protest at the proposal to abolish the seat of Gwydir and merge that electorate with Parkes. Country people have a hard enough time as it is and to lose a seat which gives them a voice in Parliament is a cruel blow.

Such a huge electorate will effectively reduce the voice of country people and this cannot surely be your intention. City people get plenty of everything – try living in the country which is much nicer, more friendly and caring but does lack an awful lot of the amenities the concrete jungle mob take for granted.
