





I wish to object in the strongest terms to the proposed re-distribution boundaries in N.S.W. namely the abolition of Gwydir and the expansion of Parkes electorate to an area of approx 380,000 square kilometres.

By creating such a huge electorate the proposal effectively reduces the voice of country people in the Federal Parliament.

It would be impossible for one member to provide fair and equitable representation to the numerous local government areas included in the proposed seat of Parkes.
