



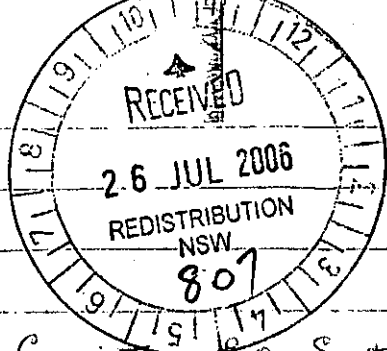

I would like to lodge a complaint regarding the proposed abolition of the seat of Gwydir & the merge into the seat of Parkes. Although you will see by my address that I no longer live in Gwydir I did live in Gwydir for 52 years & I still own country in that area & my family still live & work in the area.

In the very small, in area, electorates around Sydney it would not make very much difference to the electors if their boundaries were moved and one electorate abolished. They would still be able to travel to their member's office without travelling far. If Gwydir disappeared the electors would find it well nigh impossible to go to their member's office. It could entail many hours of travelling - AND their member would be worn out endeavouring to cover his electorate. Rural people, whether from towns or country, deserve better than this. 47% of N.S.W. is a huge area.

Our numbers may be small but it should be remembered that rural people grow the food for the cities & expect & deserve representation & those over the Dividing Range could not be getting it.
