Dear Committee Members,

It is with great concern that I write this letter to strongly oppose the proposed redistribution of NSW seats.

As proposed, the abolishment of Cwydir & the establishment of Parkes as 47% of the state is preposterous & insulting to the rural communities of N.S.W. One elected member could not effectively represent the people of rural NSW. Actually, the estimated growth rates provided by the Australian Electoral Commission do not predict Parkes or Cwydir to have the lowest rates of growth. With the resurgence in coal industry in Cwydir, the population has a very healthy forecast for the near future.

It is argued that there is a case for the abolition of a Sydney electorate. This would cause far less disruption, be more equitable than abolishing the Cwydir electorate.

I strongly urge the Redistribution Committee to redraw the NSW boundaries as a matter of urgency with due consideration to the points made above.
