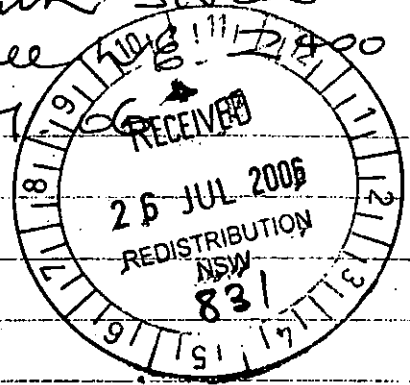

Dear Sirs, Mesdames re proposed re-distribution
of the Federal Seat of Gwydir.

I hereby express my objection to your
re-distribution Committee's above proposal because:
through the move of both the State & Federal
parliaments to corporatise, acquiring ASIC,
registration as "off-shore Registered non-reporting
corporations" which, in turn, caused local
governments to become "off-shore Registered non-
reporting corporations" (in line with regionalism
& an Australian republic despite 23.5.88 Referendum
when the sovereign people rejected such a move);
the consequent rises in rates & charges & other various
bureaucratic restrictions is causing people to move
from the land & towns, by design, to dispossess.

Thus the Federal electorate of Gwydir, believed
to be over 40% of N.S.W., has become a victim of
corporations under foreign control & financing & is
in breach of Section 44 (i) of the Australian
Constitution. Gwydir has become a victim since
population loss seems to be part of the reason for abolition.
