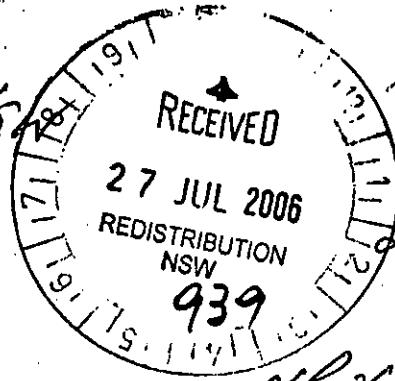

Dear Sir,

It is with grave concern that I write to record my strongest opposition to the proposed redistribution of the federal seat of Paser.

Please consider that if this proposal is accepted, that almost 50% of NSW will comprise just one electorate. The remainder of the state will have 48 members in the federal parliament.

The size of the proposed area is totally unworkable for one representative to cover all of it.

Please consider that areas such as Mantabulla, Ennawie & Dornich, remote as they are in their current electorates, would seldom if ever see their representative under the proposal.

Could I also plead with you, not only to reduce the area of Paser, but from a historical viewpoint retain Gyngdes within the federal spectrum.

Be assured we find it hard to swallow when railways & banks close - but there is no need to make us feel unworthy by lumping us into such a large area with reduced representation.

I await your response & trust that you will consider my plea favourably.
