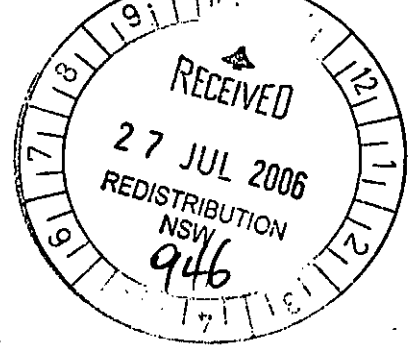

Dear Sir/Sirs,

I wish to submit an objection to the proposed re-drawing of the New South Wales federal electoral boundaries, which would eliminate the federal seat of Gwydir. And place the land area of the seat into the electorate of Parkes.

The proposal of the combined areas of Gwydir and Parkes as one Electorate would not only disfranchise the constituents of the present electorate of Gwydir. It would also remove the democratic right of the constituents of the electorate of Parkes to be properly represented in Parliament by their elected Member.

No one person could cover an area the size of which is proposed by the re-drawn boundaries and truly represent all the constituents they have trusted to them.

I ask you to reassess your Redistribution Proposal to see if there is a better way you can preserve the democratic rights of all constituents of the area, keeping in mind the tyranny of distance people in the area have to cope with.
