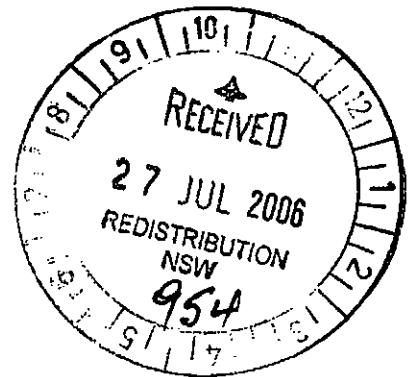

Members of the CWA Mudgees Day Branch object to the proposed change in electoral boundaries.

The change would see Parkes and Gwydir amalgamated including the entire Mudgees region.

The Member for Calare has declared that this redistribution would make a Parkes-Calare electorate "unmanageable".

The proposed change is numerically based; once again, voters living in Regional areas will be ignored. Concerns include the drought and its impact on earning capacity and lifestyle, inadequate medical, hospital and dental services and escalating fuel prices.
